

Doorway Transition Detail Between Rooms with and without Quiet Qurl®



- 1. Transition detail to be used in doorway transitioning from a room with Quiet Qurl (I.e. Hard Surfaces) to a room without (I.e. Carpeted Finish).
- 2. In addition a strip of reinforcement may be added to the 12" of Quiet Qurl extended into the non-matted room.
